Dear Comptroller Baringer,

Attached for your review and approval is the **AT&T Pots Replacement System Pricing Schedule Agreement** for the legacy copper telephone lines currently used by the City.

Please note that this agreement is not a commitment to purchase services or expend a fixed amount of funds. Instead, it establishes negotiated pricing and serves as a purchasing vehicle for AT&T Pots Replacement System (PRS) that may be procured by City departments as needed.

As part of the City's Hosted Voice System (HVS) implementation, not all City facilities are being migrated to HVS. In some cases, the size of a facility or the limited number of users does not justify deploying the HVS infrastructure. This agreement provides access to AT&T Pots Replacement System solution, which offer modern voice technologies compatible with the HVS environment. It also supports the City's long-term strategy of replacing legacy and costly POTS (Plain Old Telephone Service) lines with more efficient and unified telecommunications services.

Accordingly, this agreement establishes pricing terms only and serves as the contractual purchasing vehicle for the underlying AT&T PRS solution when needed.
